Full Seminar Description:

Though the practice of herbal medicine is seen by some as an "alternative therapy", using herbs to heal has been practiced long before what is considered modern medicine. As the field of behavioral health continues to grow, as clinicians, it is important to understand trends in the field and have a basic grasp of healing therapies that your clients may seek.
